Phase One-- *Readiness*

- Individual and Team Training
 - Basic Academy
 - Monthly Training
 - On Line Training (NASAR and FEMA)
 - Monthly Radio Checks
- Equipment Readiness
 - Personal and Team
- Planning, Policy, Procedures
 - After action review and analysis

Phase Two--*Mobilization*

- NOTIFICATION (By **Pager**)
 - Check **HOTLINE** for details 786-8711
 - Turn to Radio Channel 1 A and monitor
 - Check Map, route, and address
 - Check Weather, Clothing and Equipment
 - Drive Safely to Assembly Area-Observe Enroute
- ASSEMBLY
 - Assume Control
 - Sign In
 - Standby

Phase Three-*Operations*

- Establish Command Post
- Gather Information
- Prepare Plan
- Organize and task teams / crews
- Monitor / Control / Report
- Replan and reorganize

Phase Four – *Demobilization*

- Reassemble
- Account for people and equipment
- Hot Wash after action review
